Rosalind

Rosalind is a symmetric shawl that is knitted top-down. It is designed for two colors of solid or hand-dyed semi-solid yarn. The shawl's body is worked in stockinette stitch. With a contrasting color, a beautiful and easy to work lace border is formed.

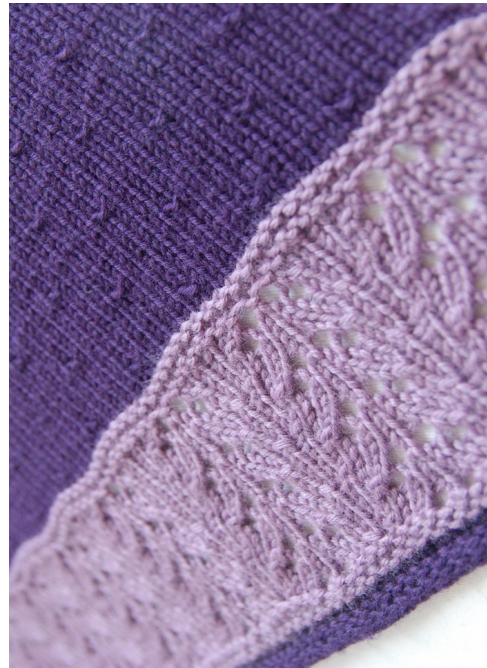
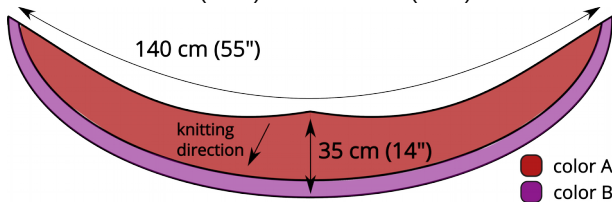


This shawl is named after the chemist Rosalind Elsie Franklin. Rosalind was born in England in 1920. She devoted herself to science and worked as an X-ray crystallographer. As a scientist, she is known for taking the first image of DNA. Her role in understanding DNA was so important that she would have won the Nobel Prize together with Watson & Crick in 1962. However, sadly she died at age 37 and the Nobel Prize is not awarded posthumously. This pattern is dedicated to a great scientist.

Finished Measurements

The finished shawl measures
35 cm (14") x 140 cm (55")



Yarn

Fingering or sport weight yarn with 320 to 400 m per 100 g in two different colors.
One skein (100 g) of each color.

Yarn suggestions

- Rosy Green Wool –
cheeky merino joy

Color combinations

The color palette of Rosy Green Wool is made to provide many colors that match.

The combinations shown in the pattern

- Blackberry (#101) &
Wild Mallow (#057)
- Rose Garden (#058) &
Wild Mallow (#057)

Needles & Notions

- One 80 cm (32") circular knitting
needle in size **3,5 mm** (US 4)
- Tapestry needle
- Blocking pins and / or blocking wire

Gauge

Gauge is not critical. As mentioned before
you can also use thinner yarn.

24 st x 34 rows

Abbreviations

k	knit
p	purl
st	stitch(es)
yo	yarn over
yo2	yarn over twice (2 loops on the needle)
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
ssk	„slip, slip, knit“; slip one stitch as if to knit to right needle, slip another stitch as if to knit. Knit these two stitches through the back loop.

Directions

Set-Up rows

With **color A** cast on 6 st.

Row 1: k1, yo, k4, yo, k1;

Row 2: p all st;

Row 3: k1, yo, k6, yo, k1;

Row 4: p all st;

Row 5: k2, yo2, k1, yo, k to last 3 st, yo, k1, yo2, k2;

Row 6: p all st (p into yo2 only 1 time);

You have 14 st on the needles.

Shawl body

Row 1: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), *k2, p1, k3,* repeat until 4 st left, * yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 2: p all st (p into yo2 only 1 time);

Row 3: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k to last 4 st, * yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 4: p all st (p into yo2 only 1 time);

Row 5: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k to last 4 st, * yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 6: p all st (p into yo2 only 1 time);

Repeat Row 1-6 until you have 320 st. Ending on a WS row.

Blending to Lace Section

Repeat with **color B**.

Row 1: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k to last 4 st, *yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 2: p7, k to last 7st (yo2 counts as 1st), p7;

Repeat 1 more time. You do have 332 st.

Lace Pattern

Row 1: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), *k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk*, repeat to last 4 st, *yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 2: p all st (p into yo2 only 1 time);

Row 3: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k3, *k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1*, repeat to last 7 st, k3 *yo, k1*, yo2, k2;

Row 4: p all st;

Row 5: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k to last 4 st, *yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2

Row 6: p all st;

Repeat row 1 – 6 three more times until you have 404 st.

Edging

For the beginning of the edging stick with color B.

Row 1: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), *k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk*, repeat to last 4 st, yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 2: p7, k to last 7st (yo2 counts as 1st), p7;

Row 3: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k to last 4 st, *yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 4: p7, k to last 7st (yo2 counts as 1st), p7;

Change to **color A** and complete the edging as followed:

Row1: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k to last 4 st, *yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 2: p all st (p into yo2 only 1 time);

Row 3: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k to last 4 st, *yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 4: p7, k to last 7st (yo2 counts as 1 st), p7;

Row 5: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k to last 4 st, *yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 6: p7, k to last 7st (yo2 counts as 1 st), p7;

Bind off loosely. Weave in all ends, wash and block shawl to finished measurements.
